Sub : Approval of All India Council for  
Technical Education for Technical  
Institutions/Programmes.

As you are aware, in accordance with the AICTE Act 52  
of 1987, all technical institutions/courses should mandatarly  
obtain AICTE's approval for conducting and continuance of the  
courses.

This, as a part of the requirement to adhere and provide  
the minimum re uirements of infrastructure, academic, faculty  
and learning resources as stipulated by AICTE, becomes applicable  
to all technical institutions which are in existence and all  
new institutions/courses proposed to be started.

While starting of any new institutions/courses/increase  
in intake can be allowed only after the prior approval of AICTE,  
even such institutions/courses which have been in existence and  
propose to continue their functioning, should obtain approval  
of AICTE latest by March'1994 if not already approved by subjecting  
themselves to assessment as per AICTE norms.

In other words, those institutions/courses who fail to  
qualify by not meeting the minimum norms and standards of AICTE  
Act, can no longer become entitled for existence includng  
affiliation rights from the academic bodies such as Universities  
and Board of Technical Examinations.


While no admissions can be made in these unapproved  
institutions, the students studying under these institutions/  
courses shall also not become eligible for approved degrees/  
diplomas awarded by the Universities/Boards of Technical

: 2 :  
This shall be applicable to all types of institutions conducting courses in Engineering, Technology, Architecture, Pharmacy, Management Studies, Applied Arts and any other Technical courses conducted both at Degree & Diploma levels included under Polytechnics, Colleges, University Departments, of Government, Private Aided & Unaided Institutions.

The Post Graduate Programmes including Business Administration etc. shall be processed centrally through the respective All India Boards of the AICTE.

All concerned institutions are therefore requested to submit their applications to the AICTE's Western Regional Office for Undergraduate and Diploma courses in the prescribed form complete with all the supported documents latest by 20-10-1993. All proposals for the Post Graduate Programmes should be sent to AICTE, New Delhi directly in standard format available from AICTE, New Delhi. Regional Office or the Headquarters of the Council may be contacted for any further details.
